 - Can you make it clearer in the plan that the Maine Department of Labor's Bureau of Rehabilitation Services Division of Vocational Rehabilitation and Division for the Blind and Visually Impaired are the grant administrators of Maine's WIOA Title IV Vocational Rehabilitation Services Programs? It is noted in the Introduction (p.4) but might also be added in the second paragraph in Section 7 B (p. 101) in the description of DVR and DBVI services.
 - Also in that same section (p. 102), our service locations are mistakenly identified as in the NWDB area but in fact are a statewide listing. Please revise to list only Bangor, Houlton, Machias and Presque Isle.
 - The Table of Contents (p.2) needs proofreading for format and duplicative sections."
